Summary of Code of Compliance for Members

- Members of the Australasian Fence Industry Association shall at all times uphold a professional image supporting the aims & objectives of the Association, promoting quality materials and installation which meets the policy guidelines.
- Members shall ensure, where required by state authorities, they hold and maintain relevant licenses to operate a business and install fencing.
- Members shall promote and comply with Australian Standards (where applicable) ensuring clients are fully aware of the options available within the Australian Standards which may suit site application.
- Quotations must clearly state whether quotation conforms to Australian Standards, or is non-conforming (clients may request a non-conforming option). Members are encouraged to note on their quotations that "This Quotation is issue in accordance with the code of conduct of the AFIA"
- Quotations must clearly state Material Specification options with their offer.
- Members shall ensure installers are fully aware of their obligations to adhere to the code of compliance for Installers
- All work carried out by members shall include a 12 month warranty period against faulty workmanship.
- Members have a responsibility to ensure that all relevant WORK HEALTH SAFETY policies and
 procedures are adhered to and that all employees and fencing installers are fully aware of all OH&S
 matters and that the public ARE not exposed to unsafe work practices.
- Members shall provide proof of an annual Certificate of Currency for Workers Compensation & Public Liability Insurance Policies on request to the Secretary of the Association.
- Members shall provide proof of a complying WORK HEALTH SAFETY policy on request to the Secretary of the Association.

Financial Members are encouraged to use and promote, at their discretion, the Association logo for advertising and stationery requirements.
